**Note:** School of Management MBA students must have an average of 5 years of work experience (minimum of 3 years).

# **Education System**

Class format is based on lectures, readings, class participation and self-study. Students are expected to attend all lectures, to complete all course-related assignments and readings, and to sit exams in order to receive a course grade.

• The academic semester has 16 weeks of class; however, some courses are taught in an 8-week period.

# Recommended Workload

#### Undergraduate

Students should register a minimum of 9 credits and a maximum of 20 credits. Students should follow the minimum requirements of their home University.

#### Master

Students should register minimum 8 credits and maximum 18 credits. Students should follow the requirements of their home University.

1 credit equals 48 hours of course work (in and out of class). It is important to remember that the ratio of classroom work vs individual work is 1 to 3 for master students and 1 to 2 for undergraduate students..

## Pass and Fail (P - F)

These grades apply for the courses that, based on determination by the Academic Council, receive non-numeric grades. The credits for courses that are passed count as graduation requirements, but they will not be taken into consideration in the calculation of semester average. (Art 55 reglamento Estudiantes de Pregrado).

# **General Information**

## Language(s) of Instruction

Most of our classes are taught in Spanish. Therefore, a B2 Spanish level is required. However, if the student is going to take courses taught in English a B2 English level and an A2 Spanish level are required.

# Spanish Course

A Spanish course is offered to all our international students; if students want to take this class, they must take the placement exam (written and oral) and register for the class officially. This class is 3 credits. http://bit.ly/3lizt0h

#### Intensive Spanish Course in July

## **Orientation Session:**

Universidad de los Andes has an orientation session of three days on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday the week before classes begin. The orientation session for international students is highly recommended.

# Health Insurance

Students must have an international travel and health insurance with a wide health and dental coverage. This is mandatory for all Free Mover students.

#### Course Fees and payment proces

Free Mover students must pay their tuition fees during the first week of classes. In order to do so, please keep in mind the following information:

1. Your invoice will not be released until you turn in your PID / Student visa

2. In order to get your invoice you need to validate your personal information at:

3. Payment methods:

- · Cash or check
- · Electronic payment PSE
- · Credit card
- · International bank transfer

Note: If you drop a class, there will be no refund.

#### For students whose nationality does not require a tourist visa:

The immigration officer at the port of entry should stamp the student's passport with the PID (Student Entry Permit) when handed the admission letter (for stays up to 180 days).

- This permit is valid for 90 days and must be renewed at Migración Colombia for another 90 days period.
- For stays longer than 180 days, a student visa is required.

For students whose nationality requires a tourist visa:

Regardless of the length of stay, a visa needs to be obtained prior to arriving in Colombia. Further information: https://bit.ly/2AsD6ug

When coming on a visa, students are required to obtain an ID card (Cédula de Extranjería) once they arrive in Colombia. This procedure must be done within 15 days after arrival to Colombia and costs approximately \$90 US Dollars. All the information about this process can be found at: https://bit.ly/3wAxsq1

**Note:** Please remember to check the entry requirements for Colombia in advance. You can verify them with the Colombian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, "Migración Colombia," or with the airline, you are going to use to travel to Colombia.

All students are responsible for obtaining their respective immigration documents. To be enrolled and registered at Uniandes students must have either the PID stamp, a visa/Cedula de Extranjería, or Cédula Colombiana (for Colombian Students)
