

## Research internships abroad for Uniandes' doctoral students

All doctoral students at Universidad de los Andes must complete an internship for at least 16 weeks in a prestigious institution (national or international) where they will conduct research tasks complementary to their doctoral program. The internship can be completed continuously or intermittently, as proposed by the student with the approval of their supervisor and the respective doctoral committee.

The internship may take place in a research group, company, or industry, as approved by the program's doctoral committee. To authorize an internship, the program's doctoral committee must receive the proposed work plan and a written communication from the host institution specifying their willingness to accept the student, previously approved by the doctoral thesis advisory committee. Generally, research internships do not require the subscription of an agreement between Uniandes and the receiving university, although in exceptional cases, the external partner will request one.
