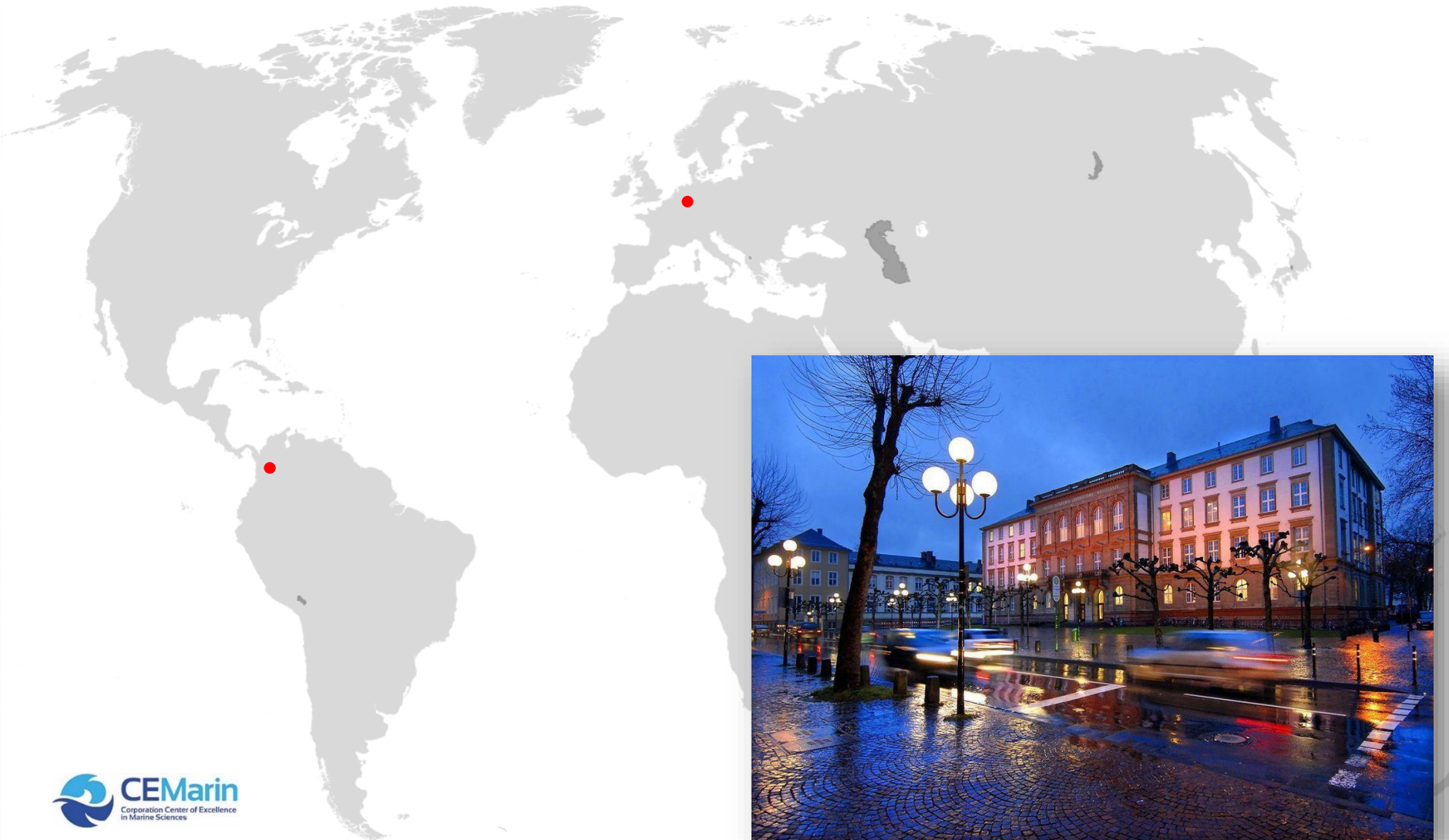

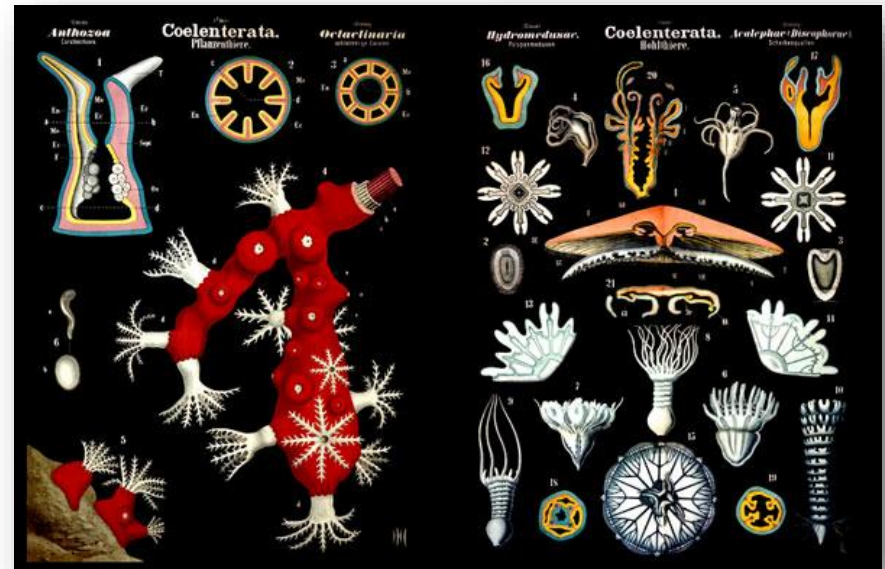

JLU – A long history of marine research

Rudolf Leuckart (1822–1898)

- First professor of zoology in Giessen (1850–1869)
- Famous parasitologist
- Intensive work on the ground plans of marine invertebrates
 - Created the phyla Coelenterata and Echinodermata
 - Worked on polymorphism of corals



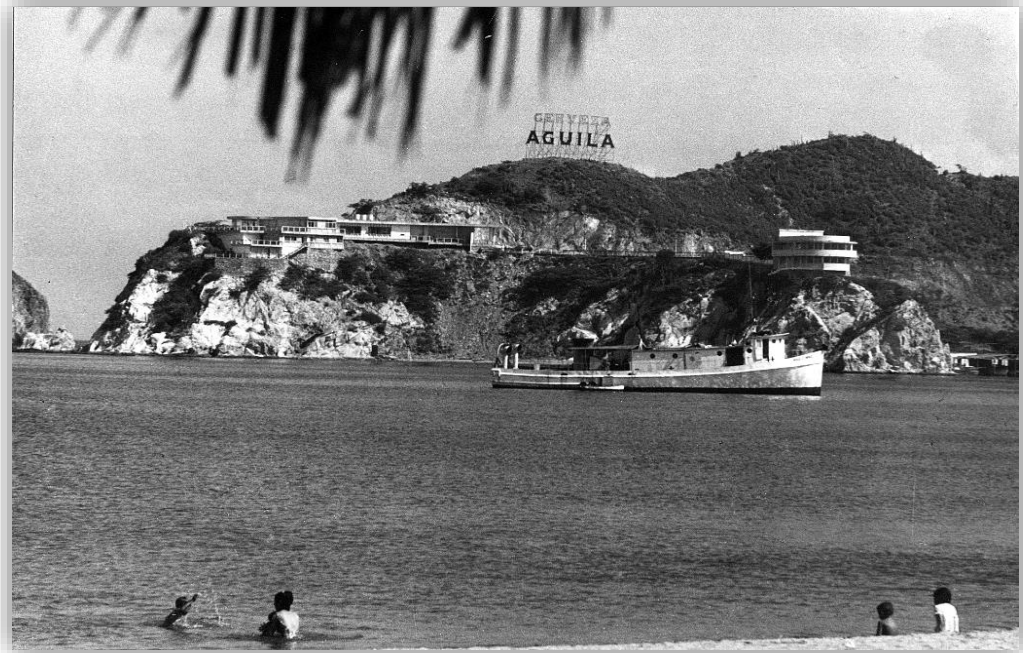
JLU – Marine research with Colombian partners

1963

Idea to establish a research station of Justus Liebig University in Santa Marta:
the *Instituto Colombo-Alemán de Investigaciones Científicas „Punta de Betín”*

1967

- Official inauguration of the *“Instituto Colombo-Alemán”*
- The first Colombian-German university partnership was established (Uniandes-JLU)

JLU – Marine research with Colombian partners

1974

The *Instituto Colombo-Alemán* becomes the *Instituto de Investigaciones Marinas y Costeras* (INVEMAR)

1975–2000

- Intensive research collaboration (e.g., PRO-CIENAGA; 1992–2000)
- JLU becomes permanent partner of the INVEMAR (1999)
