





#### PURSUING A PHD AT JLU

Different options: complete PhDs (individual & structured), bi-national, research stays

JLU: A comprehensive university with a distinct profile in the study of culture and the life sciences and an established expertise in doctoral education; PhDs can be pursued at all faculties.



Nearly 40% of our enrolled doctoral candidates, both in structured programmes and individual PhDs, are international candidates.

### BINATIONAL DOCTORATE (COTUTELLE)

- In a binational doctorate, the doctoral degree is jointly awarded by two universities in different countries.
- The binational doctorate is regulated in one individual agreement of both participating universities and is based on research performed at the two universities
- The participating universities collaborate closely in the selection, supervision and assessment of candidates and mutually recognise the respective academic achievements at the other university
- Prerequisites: one supervisor from each institution; since at least one year
  has to be spent at each university, on commencement of the joint
  enrolment at least two years of the doctorate should remain

#### SHORT RESEARCH STAYS

- In case a full PhD or Cotutelle cannot be considered, short research stays are always an option and present an excellent opportunity to add international experience to the project
- Can be included at almost any stage of the PhD study
- Duration: 1 6 months ( > DAAD funding programmes)
- Based on an individual arrangement and invitation

- social & cultural events


