

ICETEX: Expertos Internacionales

- Colombian national program to support international mobility of researchers, both incoming and outgoing.
- Financing (reimbursement) of air tickets or subsistence expenses.
- Opportunity:
 - JLU Giessen researchers visiting Uniandes.
 - Uniandes researchers visiting JLU Giessen.
- Uniandes academic units apply through Uniandes Office of International Affairs.

SGroup: ICon Grants

- SGroup network: both Uniandes and JLU Giessen are members.
- ICON: Intercontinental Academic Exchange Programme.
- Foster mobility across the SGroup network.
- Small supplementary travel grants for professors and researchers.
- 2022:
 - 3 grants from Europe to Latin America
 - 1 grant from Uniandes to Europe

Planetary Scholars & Artists in Residence Program (2022 - 2025)





- Fellowship program based at the JLU Giessen.
- Transdisciplinary dialogues between the humanities, social sciences, natural sciences and the arts.
- Three months stays (April-July or September-December).
- Call for Applications 2022: Planetary Materials
- Deadline for applications is **5**th **December, 2021.**
- Two fellowships for the summer term, two for the winter term.

- Specific agreement DFG Uniandes
- Fostering research collaboration between Uniandes and German researchers.
- Two possibilities:
 - Initiation of international collaboration.
 - Research grant projects.
- Parallel submission process.
- Proposals under this call may be submitted at any time during the year in all areas of science.

BMBF – Minciencias





- Support collaboration in science and technology between Germany and Colombia.
- Yearly joint call:
 - German partners apply at BMBF.
 - Colombian partners apply at Minciencias.
- Funding of researchers mobility in both ways.
- 2 years projects.
- Topics: Biotechnology, biodiversity, health, geosciences, marine sciences.

Alexander von Humboldt Foundation

Georg Forster Research Fellowship for researchers from developing and transition countries

- Postdoctoral researchers, experienced researchers
- Developing or transition countries
- 6–24-month research stay in Germany
- Your research must address questions relevant to the further development of your region of origin, regardless of your field.

Researchers from developing and transition countries, whose research has little or no direct relevance for the further development of their region of origin, should apply for the Humboldt Research Fellowship.

The Humboldt Foundation also grants the <u>Georg Forster Research Award</u> to internationally recognised scientists from developing and transition countries.













Alexander von Humboldt Foundation

International Climate Protection Fellowship

- Prospective leaders and postdocs with climate expertise
- Non-European developing and transition countries
- 12–24-month project in Germany
- Closing date current round: February 1st, 2022.
- Focus on combating climate change, adaptation strategies, preserving ecosystems and biodiversity, or on the sustainable use of the seas and oceans.
- Sustainability topics relating to natural resources, resourceefficient consumption or urban development are also welcome.

Feodor Lynen Research Fellowship

- Fellowship for researchers from Germany at all career levels and in all disciplines.
- Postdocs may apply for a 6- to 24-month fellowship, experienced researchers for a 6- to 18-month fellowship that can be split into up to three stays over the course of three years.
