# AGREEMENTS

## General for the entire university and Specific by faculty and/or department

**MOU-Memorandum of Understanding** 

The document describes a bilateral or multilateral agreement between parties. It expresses a convergence of desire between the parties, indicating the intention to undertake a common line of action. (Short version, max two pages)





#### **Cooperation Agreement**

The document in which the parties express their willingness to cooperate in certain areas and by carrying out activities such as the exchange of teachers and students, the exchange of publications, the joint development of research, among others (Long version, can have up to seven pages)





#### Exchange Agreement/ Academic Mobility Agreement

The document allows students enrolled in a career at UNIANDES to spend a semester or an academic year at another university. This document specifies the requirements for academic mobility to be carried out, the number of student mobility slots, and the modality: undergraduate or postgraduate. Likewise, there are academic mobility or exchange agreements for professors, researchers, and administrators.

#### **Double Degree Agreement**

The document establishes the agreement between two universities for a student of a specific program can acquire two university degrees, one from each university. For the double degree, there are special requirements among which students must comply with subject regulations of both the home university and the host university.



### **Research Agreement**

The document in which it is determined that one of the parties must provide the other with certain research services, such as the execution of a research project or the performance of technical support activities.





An MTA is an agreement between the receiving institution and the provider that governs the transfer of biological materials. It provides intellectual property protection and liability for the material providers and informs recipients of how the material may be used. Applies for transfers between academic or non-profit institutions.



#### **Co-Supervision Agreement**

The document in which two institutions agree that a student will have two thesis supervisors, one for each institution, one at the home university and the other at the host university, the completion of their studies and the approval of their thesis lead to obtaining a single degree awarded by the university of origin.



#### **Cotutelle Agreement**

The document in which two institutions agree that a specific doctoral student will receive the doctoral degree from both universities, one from the home university and one from the host university.
