

Dear International visitor:

Universidad de los Andes welcomes you and wishes your stay to be safe and fruitful. In order for you to be able to follow the biosecurity protocol, we have designed the following instructions for you to keep in mind:

- 1. You must send the following information to the unit you will visit:*
 - a. Full name*
 - b. Identification Number*
 - c. Contact telephone number*
 - d. Email address*
 - e. Date of visit the campus*
 - f. Date of arrival in Colombia*
 - g. General information about the health insurance coverage while in Colombia.*
- 2. You must comply with the instructions and biosecurity protocol for entering the campus.*
- 3. You must have international medical insurance to cover any health eventuality, including COVID-19.*
- 4. You must know the Institutional Biosecurity protocol:*
 - a. Complete document in [Spanish](#)*
 - b. Resume translated in [English](#)*
- 5. You must fill out the characterization survey in [English](#).*
- 6. [You must sign the agreement of consent](#)*

Recommendations before your travel:

1. It is recommended to keep a preventive isolation of 7 days prior to your trip to Colombia. (You should avoid public activities and crowds).

2. Once in Colombia, you should have a preventive quarantine for 5 days before entering the Campus.

If the person has a vaccination card, preventive isolation is not required.

3. It is your responsibility to check the government requirements for entry since they are changing.

In Colombia the person who does not have a vaccination card, must follow these steps:

- Preventive isolation for 7 days
- On day 5, “Comunidad Segura project” will take your PCR test and give you the results between 24 and 48 hours. In order to make an appointment, please send an email to: comunidadsegura@Uniandes.edu.co, and mention that you are an international guest arriving on (give the specific date) and you require the test.
- Comunidad segura will give you the confirmation of taking the test
- Upon receiving a negative result, you can enter the campus.

Be aware of any changes in the process.
